TIP I:

Use a Camera with high noise reduction processors, such as all the new DSLR Cameras from Nikon & Canon, or CCDs which managed to handle camera lenses. (Full Frames are preferred)

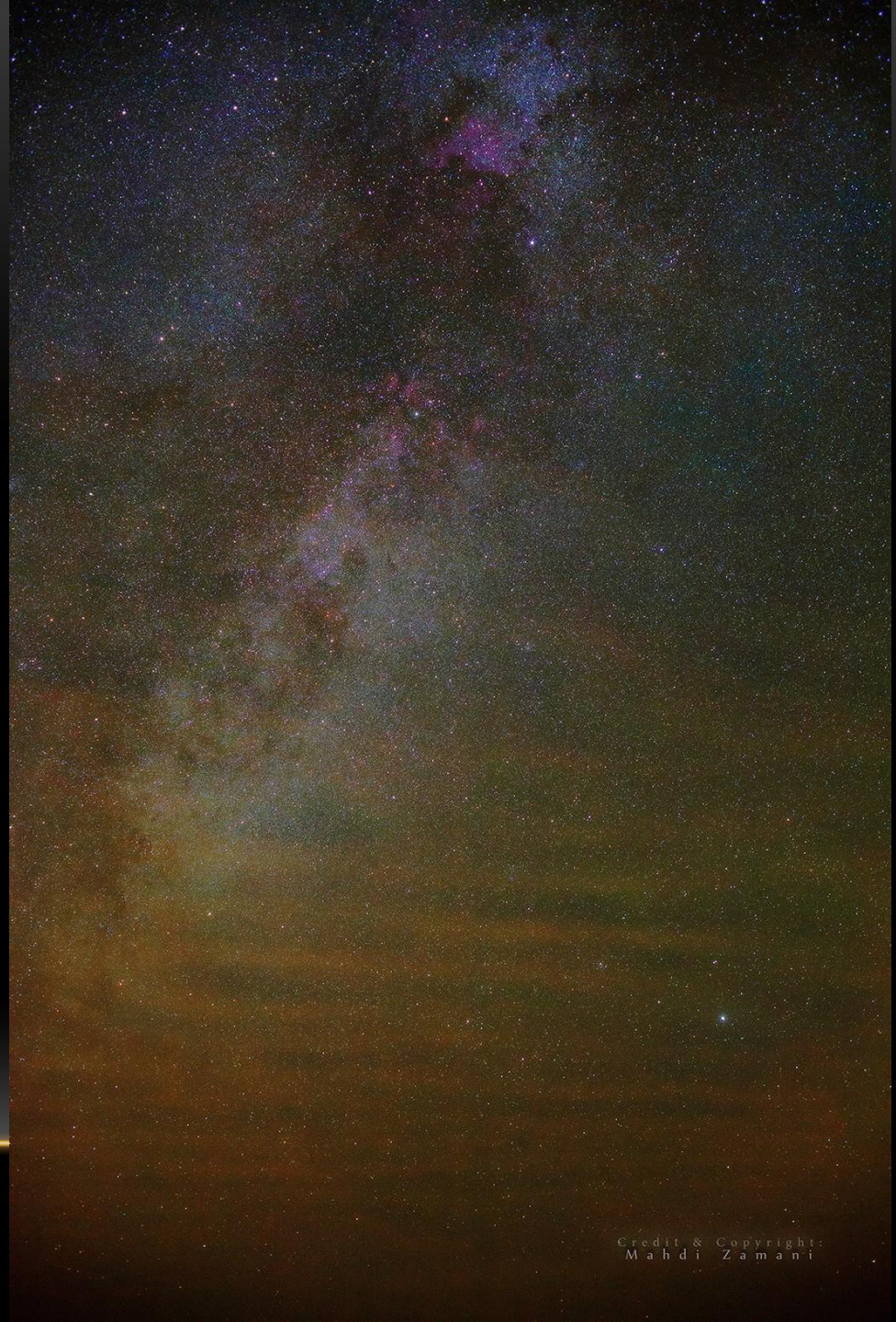
